3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jamul Indian Village  
5 Land Transfer Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TRUST LAND FOR THE JAMUL INDIAN VILLAGE OF  
7 CALIFORNIA.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The approximately 172.10 acres  
9 of land described in subsection (b) is held in trust by the  
10 United States for the benefit of the Jamul Indian Village  
11 of California.

1 (b) LAND DESCRIPTIONS.—The land referred to in  
2 subsection (a) is the following:

3 (1) PARCEL 1.—The parcels of land totaling ap-  
4 proximately 161.23 acres, located in San Diego  
5 County, California, that are held in fee by the Jamul  
6 Indian Village of California, as legally described in  
7 Document No. 2022–0010260 in the Official  
8 Records of the Office of the Recorder, San Diego  
9 County, California, and recorded January 7, 2022.

10 (2) PARCEL 2.—The parcel of land totaling ap-  
11 proximately 6 acres, located in San Diego County,  
12 California, that is held in fee by the Jamul Indian  
13 Village of California, as legally described in Docu-  
14 ment No. 2021–0540770 in the Official Records of  
15 the Office of the Recorder, San Diego County, Cali-  
16 fornia, and recorded July 29, 2021.

17 (3) PARCEL 3.—The parcel of land totaling ap-  
18 proximately 4.03 acres, located in San Diego Coun-  
19 ty, California, as legally described in Document No.  
20 1998–0020339 in the Official Records of the Office  
21 of the Recorder, San Diego County, California, and  
22 recorded January 15, 1998.

23 (4) PARCEL 4.—The parcel of land comprised  
24 of approximately 0.84 acres, located in San Diego  
25 County, California, as legally described in Document

1 No. 2017–0410384 in the Official Records of the  
2 Office of the Recorder, San Diego County, Cali-  
3 fornia, and recorded September 7, 2017.

4 (c) ADDITIONAL TRUST ACQUISITION.—The Sec-  
5 retary of the Interior shall accept title in and to, and place  
6 into trust by the United States for the benefit of the  
7 Jamul Indian Village of California, the land depicted as  
8 “Proposed 1.1. acres” on the map of the California De-  
9 partment of Fish and Wildlife entitled “Amended Acres  
10 Proposal” and dated May 2023 if that land is conveyed  
11 or otherwise transferred to the United States by, or on  
12 behalf of, the Jamul Indian Village of California.

13 (d) ADMINISTRATION.—Land taken into trust under  
14 subsections (a) and (c) shall be—

15 (1) part of the reservation of the Jamul Indian  
16 Village of California; and

17 (2) administered in accordance with the laws  
18 and regulations generally applicable to property held  
19 in trust by the United States for the benefit of an  
20 Indian Tribe.

21 (e) GAMING PROHIBITED.—Land described in sub-  
22 sections (b) and (c) shall not be used for any class II gam-  
23 ing or class III gaming under the Indian Gaming Regu-  
24 latory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) (as those terms are  
25 defined in section 4 of that Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)).
